I hope this letter finds you well. As per state statute, MS Code 19-19-5, the Mississippi Constables Association will be conducting an 80-hour Constable Training Class April 1- 5, April 8-12, 2024. The Class will be conducted by MS Delta Community College Law Enforcement Training Academy in Moorehead, MS 39761.

This will be a 2 week stay on campus class and the Constables will be able to come home on Friday evenings. If you live close by you are permitted to drive back and forth to the class.
